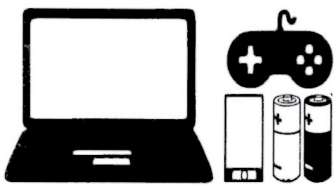

**HEAVY PENALTIES APPLY
NO RETURN POLICY
ON PROHIBITED ITEMS**

1. I, _____, declare that I am the sender who packed my air cargo shipment.
2. I am aware and take full responsibility of all the risk, that i have read and understood the new Australian aviation security regulation above.
3. I declare that my air cargo shipment has no any dangerous / explosive items or substances inside like aerosol cans, batteries, gas, perfumes and wines.
4. I also declare that my air cargo shipment is for personal use only with no commercial goods.
- 4a. AIR CARGO SHIPMENT found with commercial quantity will be subject to extra Philippine Customs duties and taxes and extra storage. BM Express will also charge AU\$150 to cover the handling fee & extra expenses incurred due to cargo examination reprocessing.
5. I am taking the full responsibility that it will be subject for Australian airline security penalty of AU\$1000 and my air cargo shipment will be confiscated once any prohibited items has been found inside.

INSTRUCTIONS : To avoid delays in the processing and release of your Balikbayan Boxes, please fill out All fields below. Please type or print legibly in capital letters.

HOW MANY COPIES OF THE INFORMATION SHEET DO I NEED PER BOX? You need 3 copies of the Information Sheet **per box**. The 1st copy is attached to the box; the 2nd copy is given to the Consolidator; and the 3rd copy is your copy as the Sender.

WHO CAN SEND BALIKBAYAN BOXES TO THE PHILIPPINES? Anyone can send Balikbayan Boxes to the Philippines, even Corporations, Partnerships and Sole Proprietors. But only a Qualified Filipino While Abroad¹ can avail of the tax and duty-free privilege of balikbayan boxes under Section 800 (g) of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA).

WHO ARE QUALIFIED FILIPINO CITIZENS WHILE ABROAD?? They are Resident Filipinos³, Non-Resident Filipinos⁴ and Overseas Filipino Workers⁵.

WHAT IS THE SECTION 800 (G) PRIVILEGE UNDER THE CMTA OR THE BALIKBAYAN BOX PRIVILEGE? This is the privilege given to a Qualified Filipino Citizen While Abroad to send Balikbayan Boxes to a Family Member or Relative⁶, tax and duty free.

HOW MANY TIMES CAN I SEND BALIKBAYAN BOXES? There is no limit *unless* you will avail of the Balikbayan Box Privilege.

HOW MANY TIMES CAN I AVAIL THE BALIKBAYAN BOX PRIVILEGE? A Qualified Filipino While Abroad¹ can avail of the balikbayan box privilege up to 3 times or up to 3 shipments in a calendar year⁷. The total amount of all the shipments should not be more than Php 150,000.00 in a calendar year.

HOW MANY BALIKBAYAN BOXES CAN I SEND IN 1 SHIPMENT IF I WILL AVAIL OF THE BALIKBAYAN BOX PRIVILEGE? There is no limit to the number of Balikbayan Boxes that you can send per shipment but the size of the boxes must be no bigger than .20 cbm (about the size of an XL box) and the total value should not be more than Php 150,000.00 in a calendar year.

WHAT CAN I PUT IN MY BALIKBAYAN BOX IF I WANT TO AVAIL OF THE BALIKBAYAN BOX PRIVILEGE? You can only send household effects⁸ and personal effects⁹. You cannot send items which are in commercial quantities¹⁰ (a good rule of thumb is not more than 20 items of each kind for consummable goods and not more than 5 items of each kind for non-consummable goods), or send items which are for sale, barter or hire, or those which are prohibited¹¹ or restricted¹². Importations of up to 2 litres (2000 ml) of wine and liquor, 2 reams of cigarettes and 50 sticks of cigars shall be subject to payment of excise tax only. Any excess is subject to duty, VAT and excise tax.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DECLARE THAT I WANT TO AVAIL OF THE BALIKBAYAN BOX EXCEED THE ALLOWED QUANTITIES OR VALUES? Anything in excess of the allowable quantity, amount or frequency shall be subject to duties and taxes, and civil and criminal liabilities, if any.

WHAT IF THE VALUE OF MY SHIPMENT IS LESS THAN PHP10,000.00? You can avail of the De Minimis privilege and you don't need to be a Qualified Filipino While Abroad but you must have only 1 consignee or recipient. An invoice or equivalent document is required for immediate release of shipments sent by or to be received by a Corporation, Partnership or Sole Proprietorship. Even if you are a Qualified Filipino While Abroad a De Minimis Value¹³ shipment shall not be counted as an avallment under the Balikbayan Box privilege.

INSTRUCTIONS : You must check one type of availment only. You may only avail of the Balikbayan Box Privilege, if you are a Qualified Filipino While Abroad.
